LITs will be scheduled on a half-day basis only. LITs will work 8:45-12:00 or 12:15 to 3:00 pm. There are no scheduled lunch breaks for LITs. LITs are required to follow the same guidelines as the rest of the staff. LITs will be selected based on experience, availability, answers to questions on the application, and references. LITs who volunteered previously are not guaranteed new LIT assignments, nor are they guaranteed paid counselor positions in future years. All LIT applicants are reviewed and considered each summer. LIT applicants must be entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade in the Fall. Once the selection process is complete, LIT applicants will be mailed a letter in April/May with selected weeks and time slots. Please select the maximum/minimum weeks you want/can work. Keep in mind any requests to be with a certain age group, another LIT or a sibling will be at the discretion of the Program Director.*
