Florham Park Memorial First Aid Squad

Some seniors may not be aware that the First Aid Squad now charges a flat fee for service plus an extra charge for additional services such as oxygen or special equipment.

The 72-year old FP Memorial First Aid Squad had to make changes to their previously free service due to low volunteerism and several other factors.

After receiving FP First Aid Squad services, a patient may receive a bill and/or a statement in the mail. Bills should be filled out with the requested information and returned to the billing company for processing so the Squad can be reimbursed for their services.


