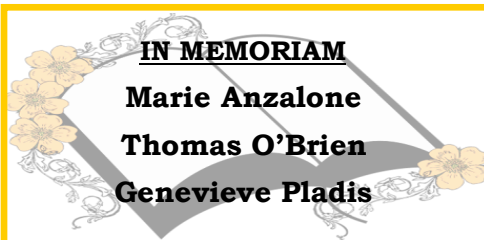

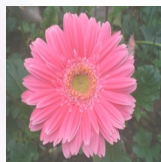
Give Mid-day Meditation a try. It's held on Wednesdays from Noon to 1 p.m. at the Florham Park Library.

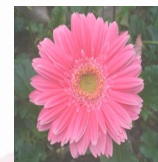
