By signing below, I certify that I and/or anyone working on the site indicated above will follow the rules below. I understand that fines may apply if the hydrant is not used properly.

-Prior to using the hydrant, a meeting must be held with the Water Department and whoever will be making the connection. **The Water Department will indicate which hydrant can be used** and witness someone onsite making a proper connection prior to granting the permit. **Hydrant use cannot begin until the permit is approved.**

-A properly functioning and calibrated backflow preventer must be attached between the hose and the hydrant.

-Limit of 8 hours of use per day. Hydrants may only be used on week days.

-Only a hydrant key can be used to open the hydrant; **NO WRENCHES OR OTHER TOOLS**

-Hose must be detached and hydrant properly capped nightly

-Property owner is responsible for all damage to the hydrant during the permit period.

-Property owner is responsible for all fees associated with Water Department callouts due to hydrant issues or water flow in the hydrant use area

-The Borough of Florham Park reserves the right to limit or cease hydrant usage at any time.

-The Permit fee for temporary hydrant usage is \$588, and the daily usage fee is \$840.00. Fees will be billed weekly, and must be paid prior to the issuance of permits. **It is the responsibility of the property owner to notify the Water**

**Department when hydrant use is complete. After this, the hydrant may not be used again without a new permit. The Water Department will inspect the hydrant after being notified that usage has stopped. Billing will continue for all week days until the Department has been notified that the hydrant is no longer connected to a hose.**
